How the course is run

Session 1 will be a face to face practical bandaging workshop which will be held at Accelerate Head Office in the Garden Room, St. Joseph's Hospice, Mare Street, Hackney E8 4SA. NB please wear suitable clothing for a practical session.

Session 2 will be held on-line using the Zoom platform with pre and post learning quizzes, presentations (pre-recorded and live) and Q & A sessions.

need peace and quiet!

Zoom is FREE, easy to download and simple to use - you will need to have your account set up and tested in advance of the training day to ensure there are no connectivity issues.
