About your courses

These courses will support the continuous professional development needs of clinicians - each module can count for participatory learning hours for continuing professional development or NMC revalidation. Brief content for each course is given below.

1. Leg ulcer management one-day refresher - face to face

This workshop is suitable for those already trained in lower limb and leg ulcer management who are in need of an update

- Refresh you clinical assessment skills including ABPI / Doppler assessment
- Revisit how to skillfully apply inelastic bandage systems to manage lower limb ulceration and swelling
- Review how to measure for compression hosiery and wraps
- Discus safety netting and escalation in infection or unusual aetiologies

2. Developing skills in leg ulcer management - A 3 day virtual course

This course is suitable for beginners

- Perform a holistic assessment of a patient presenting with a lower leg wound
- Identify whether the patient would be suitable for compression therapy by performing a vascular assessment (Doppler) to record ankle brachial pressure index (ABPI) and be able to interpret the results
- Identify the best options of compression therapy in partnership with the patient. Learners will understand the importance of correct application of the chosen method, such as compression wraps, bandages or hosiery
