You will be working with national experts and key opinion leaders who are skilled in the creative and person centred approach to leg ulcer management. This is a competency based three day training programme aimed at those who manage patients with lower limb wounds and can count for up to 18 hours of participatory learning for NMC revalidation.

Learning outcomes

- Perform a holistic assessment of a patient presenting with a lower leg wound.
- Identify whether the patient would be suitable for compression therapy by performing a vascular assessment (Doppler) to record ankle brachial pressure index (ABPI) and be able to interpret the results.
- Identify the best options of compression therapy in partnership with the patient. Learners will understand the importance of correct application of the chosen method, such as compression wraps, bandages or hosiery.
